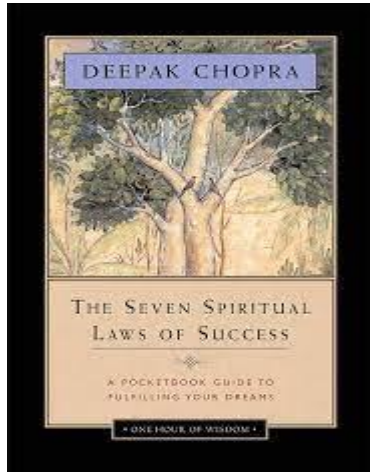

1. The Seven Spiritual Laws of Success: A Pocketbook Guide to Fulfilling Your Dreams/ Deepak Chopra



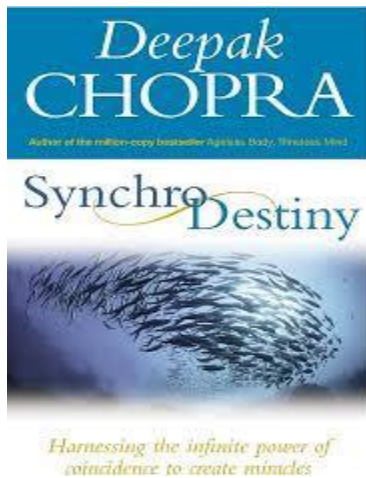

2. Synchro Destiny/ Deepak Chopra



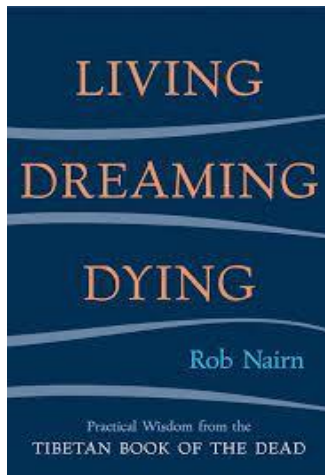

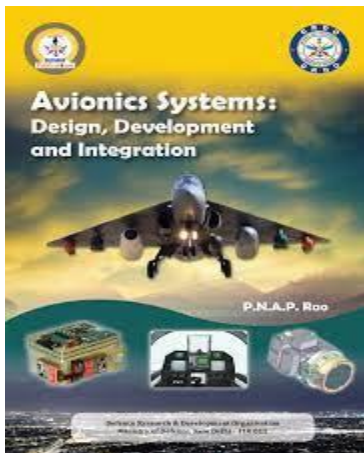

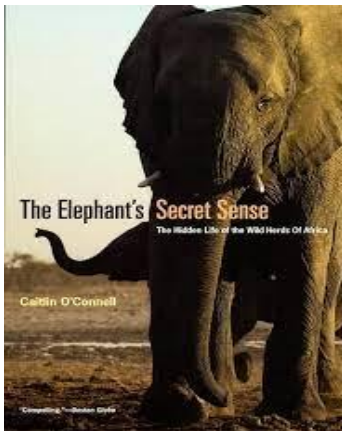

5. The Elephants Secret Sense – The Hidden Life of the Wild Herds of Africa/ Caitlin O Connell



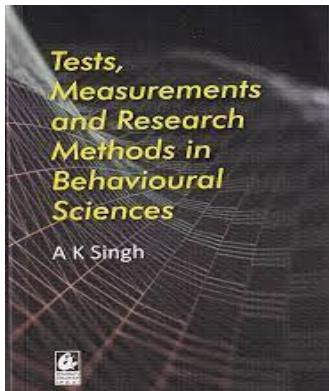

6. Tests, Measurements and Research Methods in Behavioural Sciences/ A K Singh



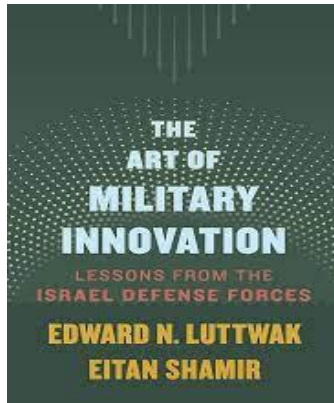

7. The Art of Military Innovation Lessons from the Israel Defense Forces/ Edward N. Luttwak



A world-leading military strategist and an IDF insider explain the improbable success of the Israeli armed forces.

When the Israel Défense Forces was established in May 1948, it was small, poorly equipped, and already at war. Lacking sufficient weaponry or the domestic industrial base to produce it, the newborn military was forced to make do with whatever it could get its hands on. This unique structure, coupled with a young officer corps, allows for initiative from below. The result is a nimble organization inclined toward change rather than beholden to tradition.
